¹ Generation status Generation status refers to whether or not the person or the person's parents were born in Canada.

² Age 'Age' refers to the age of a person (or subject) of interest at last birthday (or relative to a specified, well-defined reference date).

exclusively a man or a woman). Gender includes the following concepts: gender identity, which refers to the gender that a person feels internally and individually; gender expression, which refers to the way a person presents their gender, regardless of their gender identity, through body language, aesthetic choices or accessories (e.g., clothes, hairstyle and makeup), which may have traditionally been associated with a specific gender. A person's gender may differ from their sex at birth, and from what is indicated on their current

⁴ Given that the non-binary population is small, data aggregation to a two-category gender variable is sometimes necessary to protect the confidentiality of responses provided. In these cases, individuals in the category "non-binary persons" are distributed into the other two gender categories and are denoted by the "+" symbol.

⁵ Religion Religion refers to the person's self-identification as having a connection or affiliation with any religious denomination, group, body, or other religiously defined community or system of belief. Religion is not limited to formal membership in a religious organization or group. For infants or children, religion refers to the specific religious group or denomination in which they are being raised, if any.

Employment Equity Act defines visible minorities as persons other than Aboriginal peoples who are non-Caucasian in race or non-white in colour." In 2021 Census analytical and communications products the term "visible minority" has been replaced by the terms "racialized population" or "racialized groups" reflecting the increased use of these terms in the public sphere."

¹² Religion" refers to a person's self-identification as having a connection or affiliation with any religious denomination group, body or other religiously defined community or system of belief. Religion is not limited to formal membership in a religious organization or group. This variable includes detailed responses to the religion question. However, a number or detailed religion categories have been aggregated into broader categories for this variable. For many religions, respondents may be more likely to provide more general responses than more specific responses. For example, someone who is affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church may simply report "Lutheran" as their religion rather than the more specific response of "Evangelical Lutheran Church". As a result, estimates of many of these more
