- ¹ Generation status - Generation status refers to whether or not the person or the person's parents were born in Canada.
- ² Age - "Age" refers to the age of a person (or subject) of interest at last birthday (or relative to a specified, well-defined reference date).
- ³ Population group - Population group refers to whether the person reports being White, South Asian, Chinese, Black, Filipino, Arab, Latin American, Southeast Asian, West Asian, Korean, Japanese and/or another population group. These specific groups are the mark-in categories used in a question which collects data on the visible minority population for employment equity purposes.
- ⁴ Visible minority - Visible minority refers to whether a person is a visible minority or not, as defined by the Employment Equity Act. The Employment Equity Act defines visible minorities as persons other than Aboriginal peoples who are non-Caucasian in race or non-white in colour. The visible minority population consists mainly of the following groups: South Asian, Chinese, Black, Filipino, Arab, Latin American, Southeast Asian, West Asian, Korean and Japanese."
- ⁵ Population group - Population group refers to whether the person reports being White, South Asian, Chinese, Black, Filipino, Arab, Latin American, Southeast Asian, West Asian, Korean, Japanese and/or another population group. These specific groups are the mark-in categories used in a question (Question 25) which collects data on the visible minority population for employment equity purposes.
- ⁶ The population group variable provides a distribution of single and selected combinations of multiple responses to the population group question. For estimates of the visible minority population, please use the variable Visible minority."

- ⁹ "Visible minority" refers to whether a person is a visible minority or not as defined by the Employment Equity Act. The Employment Equity Act defines visible minorities as "persons other than Aboriginal peoples who are non-Caucasian in race or non-white in colour." The visible minority population consists mainly of the following groups: South Asian, Chinese, Black, Filipino, Arab, Latin American, Southeast Asian, West Asian, Korean and Japanese. In 2021 Census analytical and communications products the term "visible minority" has been replaced by the terms "racialized population" or "racialized groups" reflecting the increased use of these terms in the public sphere."

- ¹² The abbreviation n.i.e." means "not included elsewhere." This category includes persons who provided responses that are classified as a visible minority but that cannot be classified with a specific visible minority group. Such responses include, for example, "Guyanese," "Pacific Islander," "Polynesian," "Tibetan" and "West Indian."
- ¹³ In 2021 Census analytical and communications products, this category is referred to as the rest of the population."
- ¹⁴ "First generation" includes persons who were born outside Canada. For the most part, these are people who are now, or once were, immigrants to Canada.
- ¹⁵ "Second generation" includes persons who were born in Canada and had at least one parent born outside Canada. For the most part, these are the children of immigrants.
- ¹⁶ "Third generation or more" includes persons who were born in Canada with all parents born in Canada.
