Only **0.2%** of Newfoundland and Labradorians lived in apartments in a building that has five or more storeys.

singledetached

The most common household type is single-detached homes with **75.9%**

other attached

23.4%

Includes row houses, semi-detached houses, apartment or flat in a duplex, apartment in a building that has fewer than five storeys and other single-attached houses.




movable dwelling

Includes mobile homes and other movable dwellings such as houseboats and railroad cars.
