



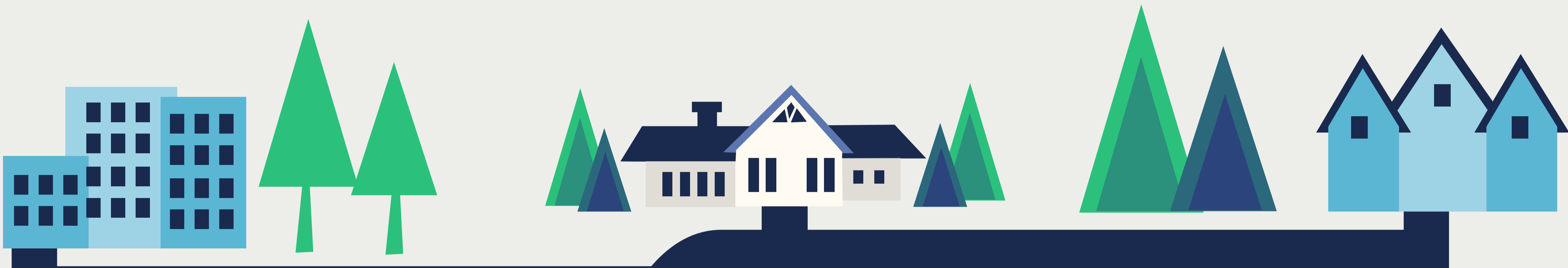

apartments

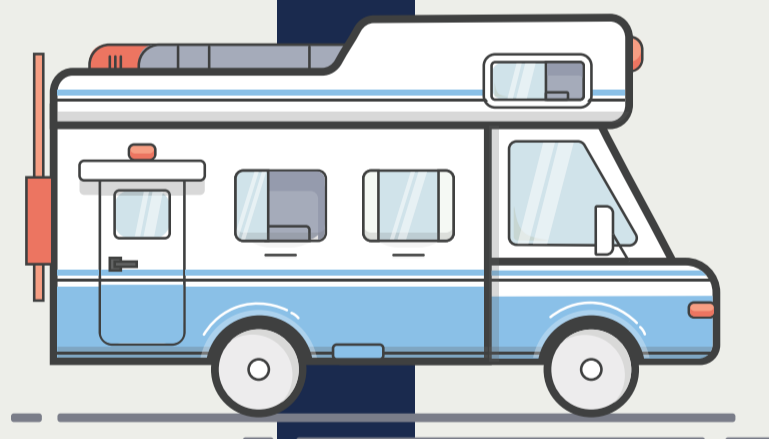
Only **0.4%** of Newfoundland and Labradorians lived in apartments in a building that has five or more storeys.

Includes row houses, semi-detached houses, apartment or flat in a duplex, apartment in a building that has fewer than five storeys and other single-attached houses.

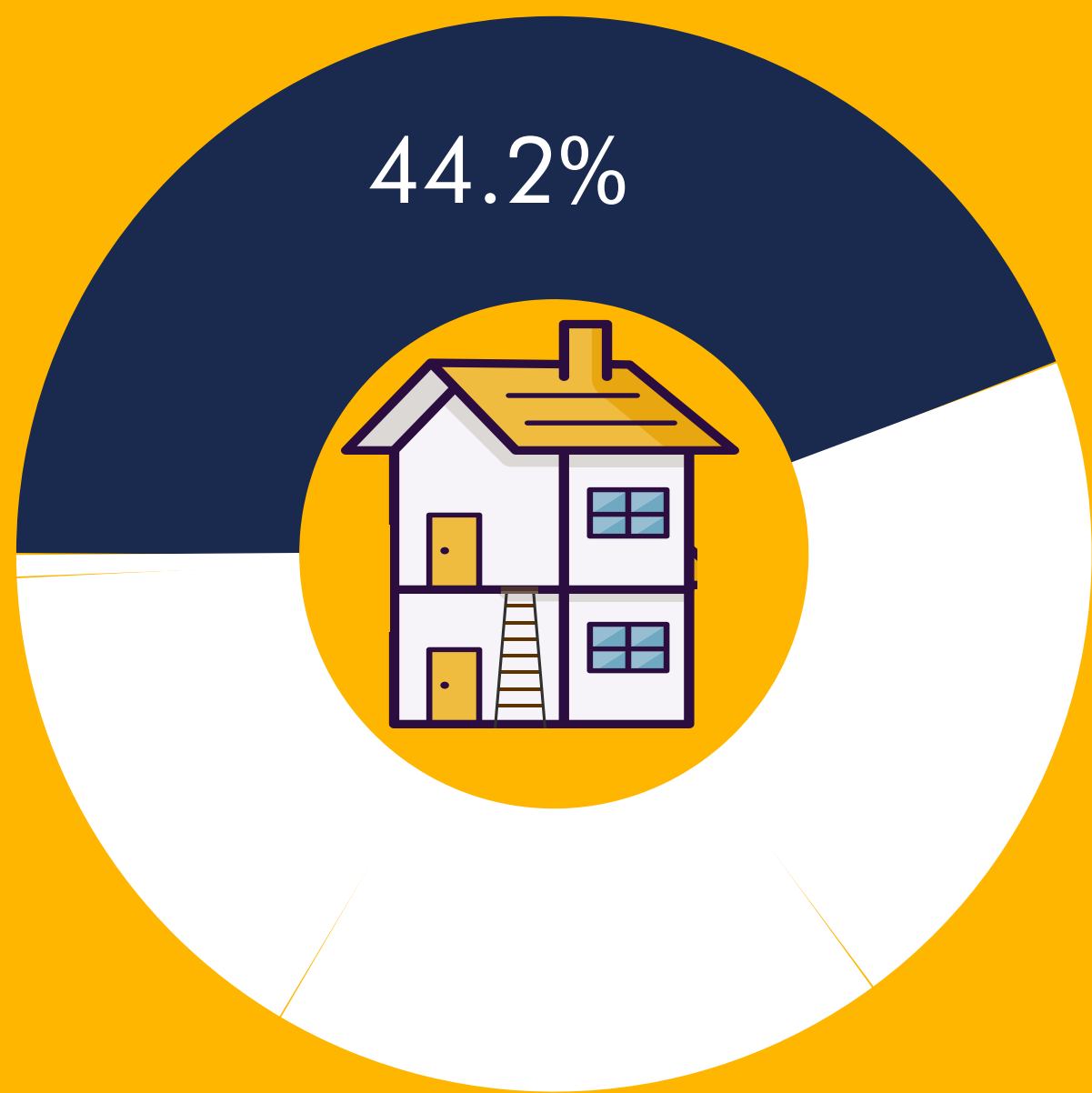


movable dwelling

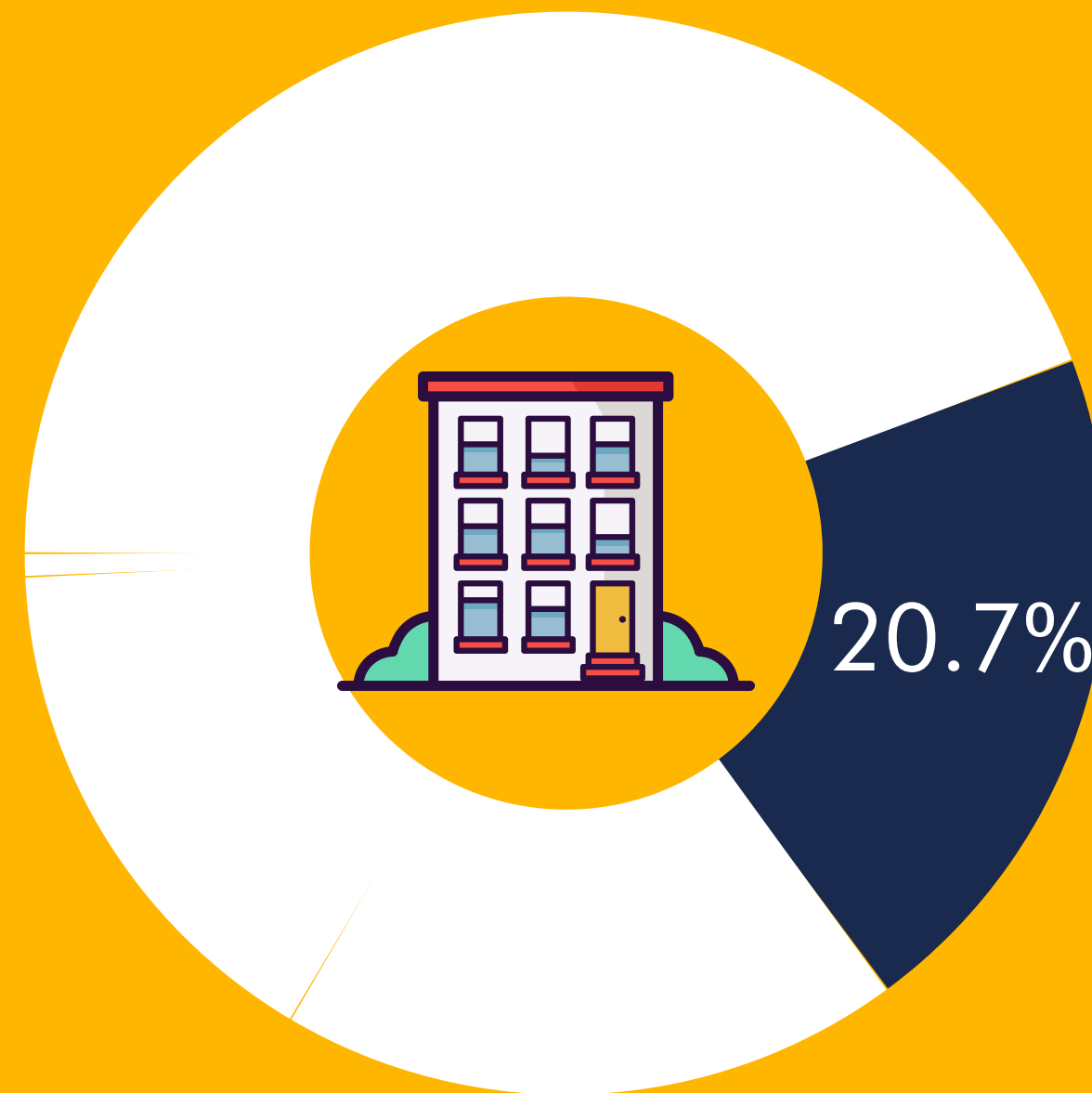

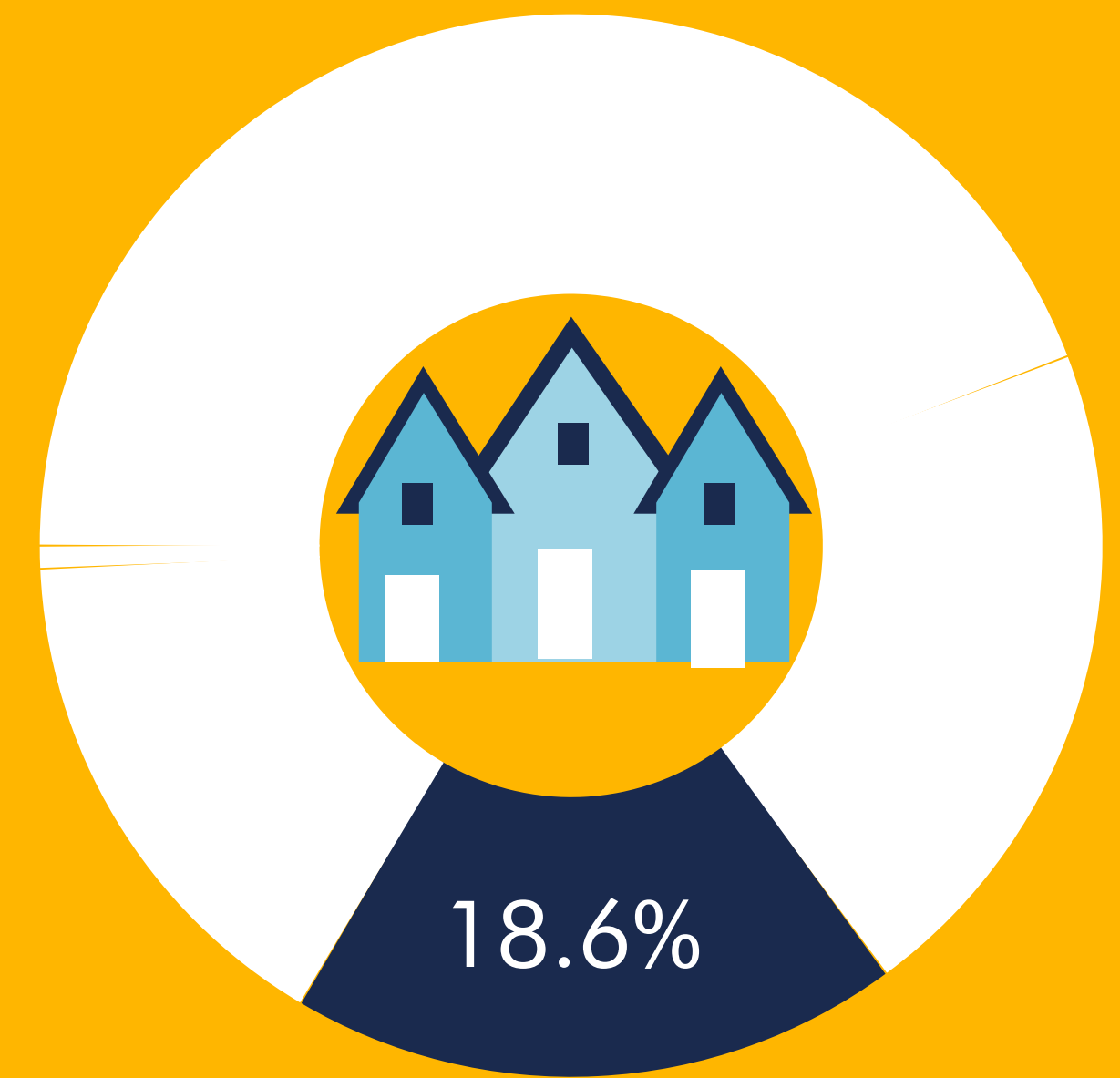
Other Attached Dwelling Breakdown



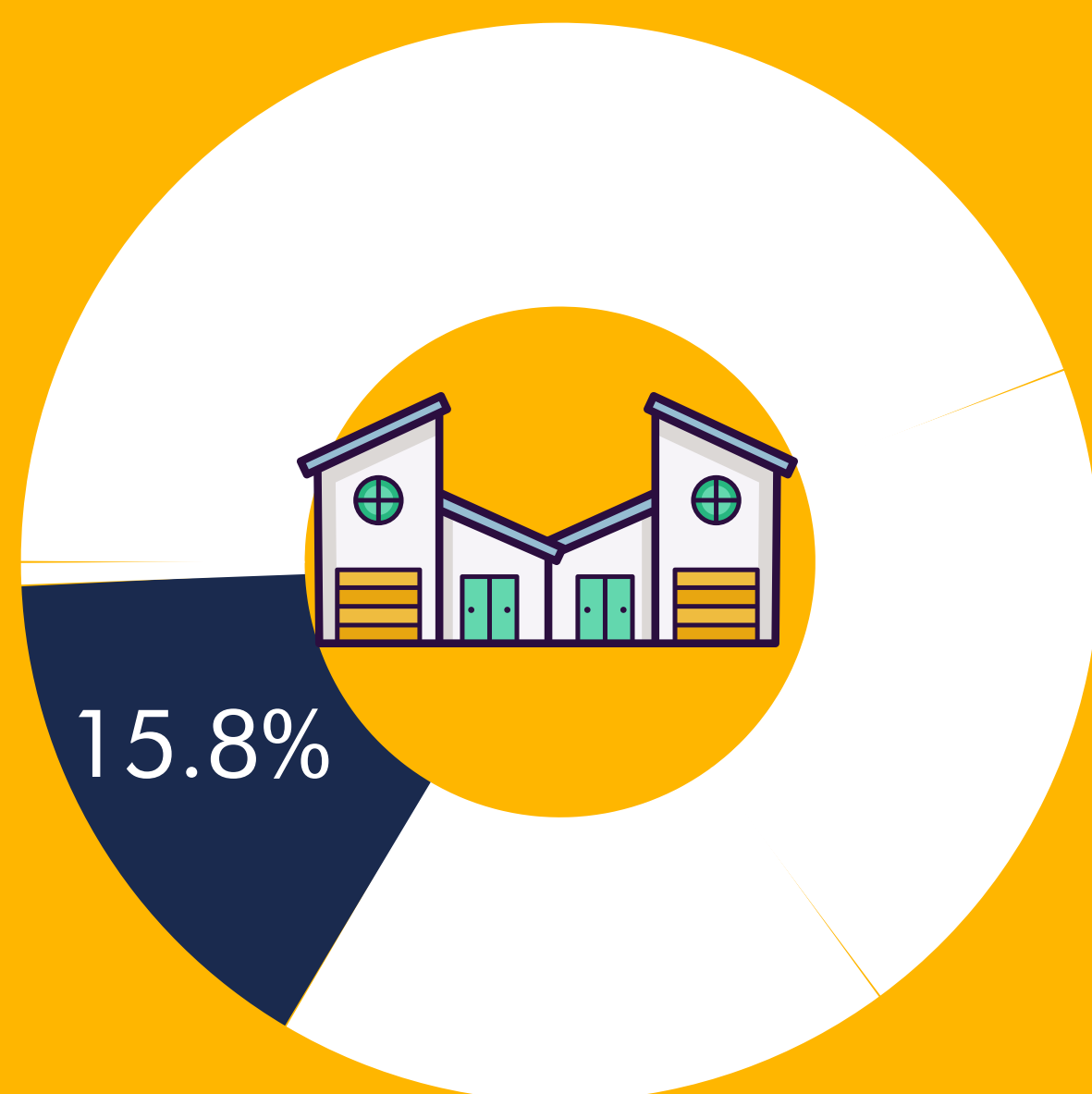
Apartment or flat in a duplex



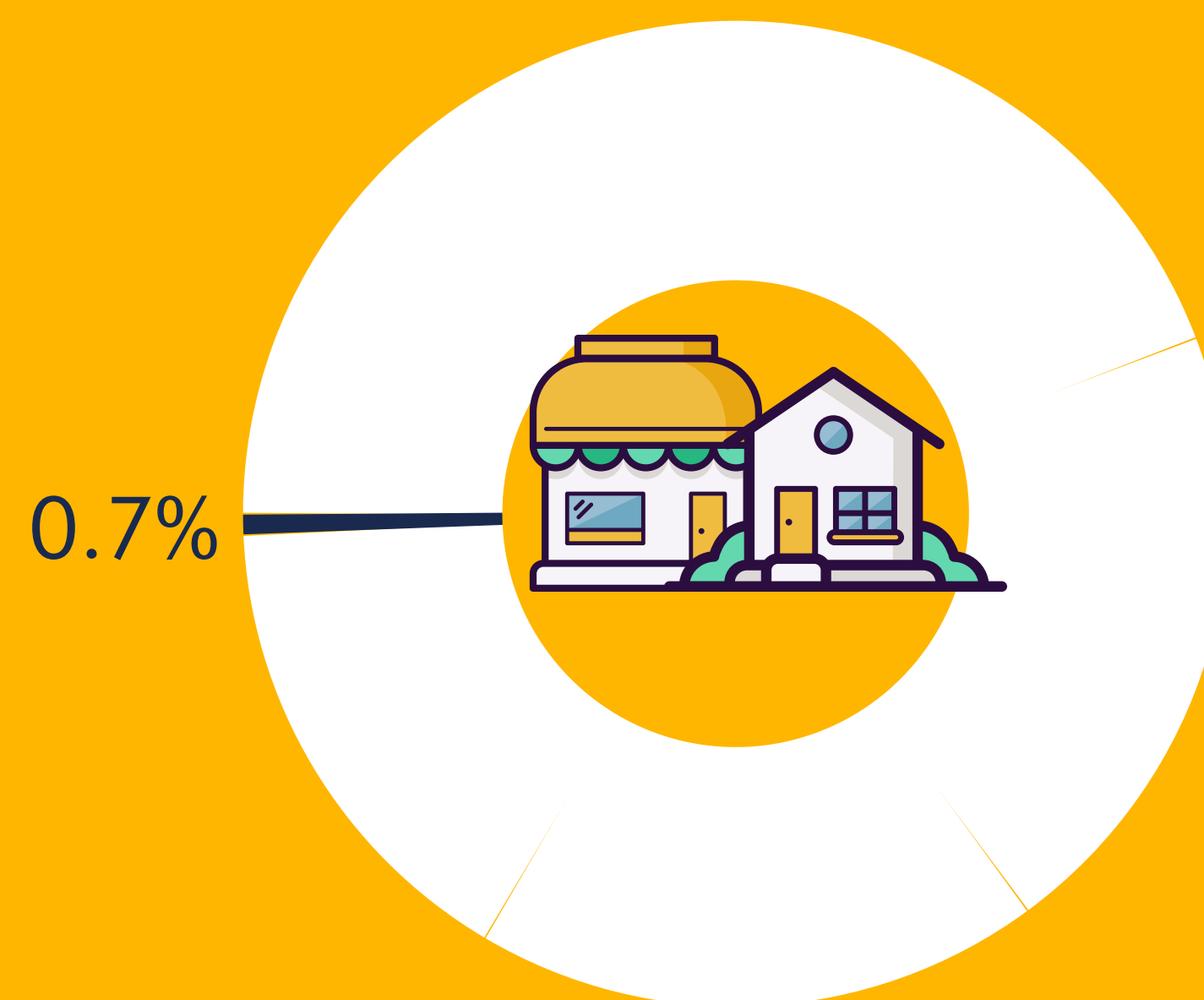
Apartment in a building that has fewer than five storeys



Row house

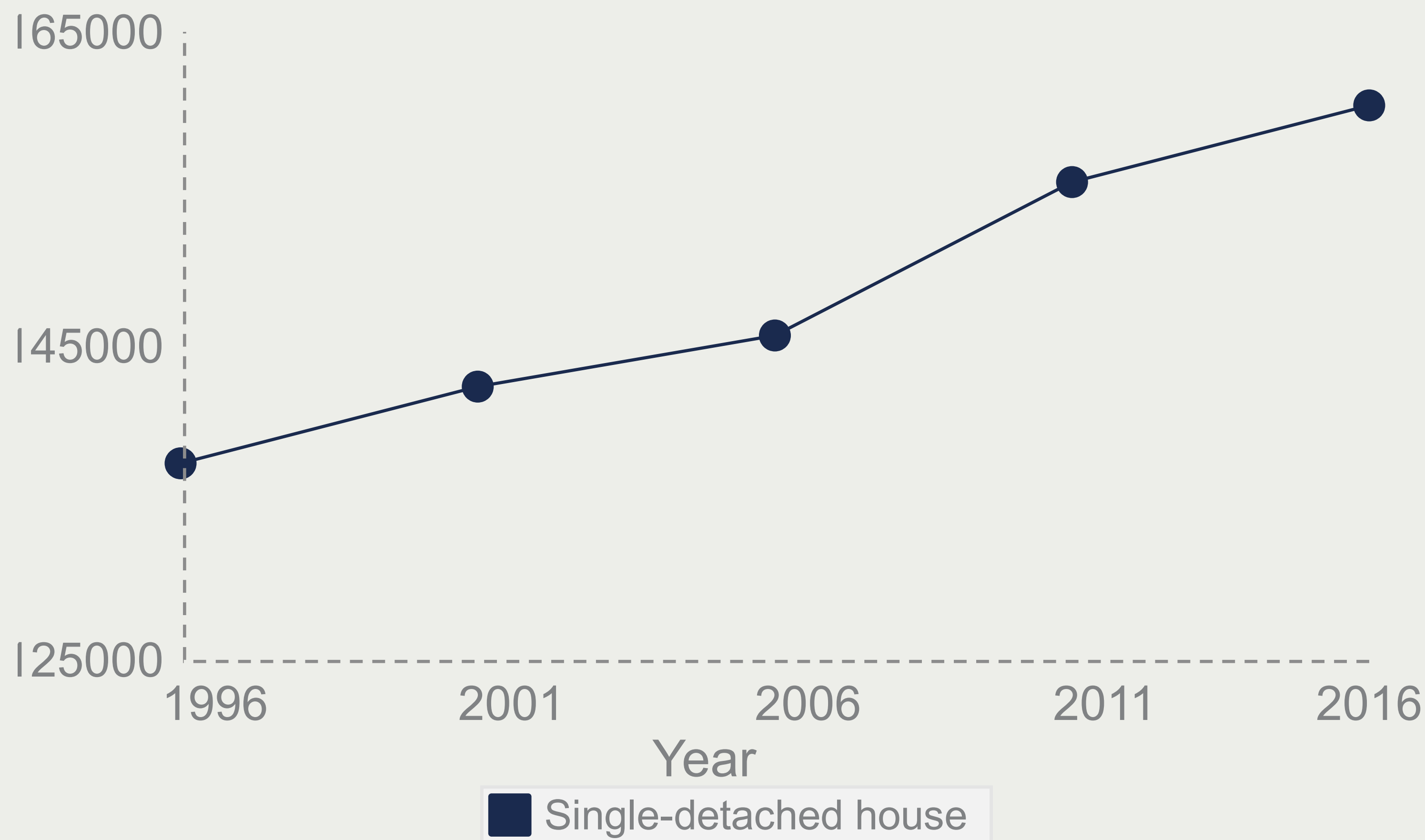


Semi-detached house

16.7%

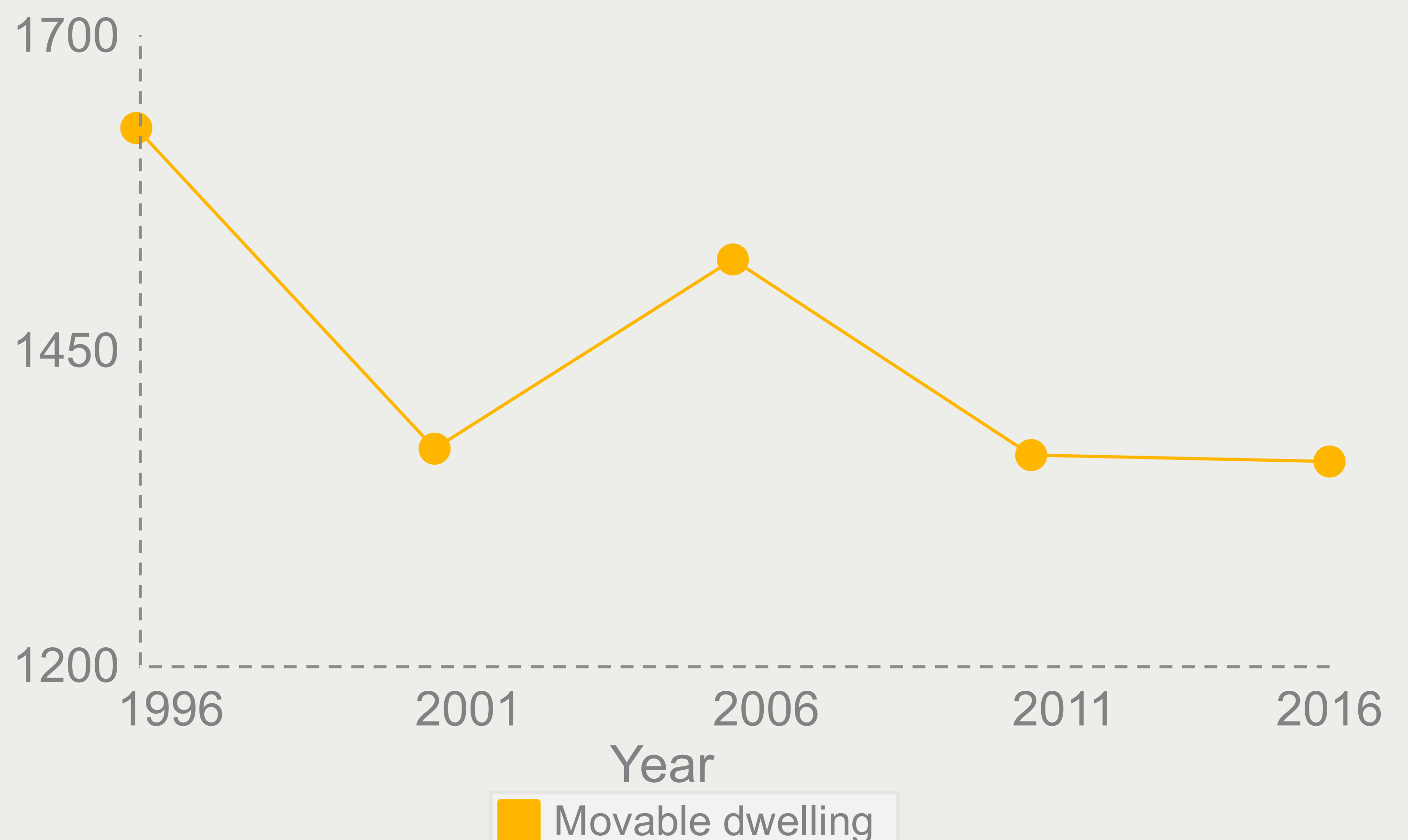
